MoU signed

ISLAMABAD, April 26: The National AIDS Control Programme and the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and Empowerment of Women (UN Women) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to enhance collaboration to ensure implementation of the national commitments on gender equality in the perspective of fight against HIV/AIDS.

According to a statement issued by the UN Women on Tuesday, the MoU was signed by NACP acting National Programme Manager Amir Maqbool and UN Women Country Programme Director Alice Shackelford. The statement said that the institutionalisation of gender in the HIV response would focus on the linkages between violence against women and HIV and AIDS and on the provision of technical assistance to reinforce gender perspective in the national strategic framework. —Our Reporter
